Dear Friends,

Flowers and other Christmas decorations placed on gravesites at St. Augustine Catholic Cemetery will be removed beginning Monday, January 20.

Requests for statements detailing your 2019 contributions to Sacred Heart Church can be made by sending an e-mail to the parish office ([unitedinthesacredheart@aol.com](mailto:unitedinthesacredheart@aol.com)) or by calling the parish office during regular business hours. Statements are available only to registered members of the parish (those who receive and use their parish envelopes) and should be available by January 31.

Both the Parish Office and the Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery Office will be closed Monday, January 20, for the national holiday honoring Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

The annual March for Life takes place in Washington, DC this Friday, January 24. Please remember to pray for those who travel for the March. This month's parish Holy Hour will take place the eve prior to the March, Thursday, January 23 at 7 PM. The Holy Hour consists of praying of the Rosary, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Evening Prayer, and Benediction. All are invited to attend.

Today's parish bulletin has a notice for a trip to the Sight and Sound Theatre to see "Queen Esther" on Thursday, April 30. All interested in attending are highly encouraged to make their reservations as soon as possible, for there are only 50 spots available.

Several 6:30 AM and 8 AM Masses on weekdays remain available for specific intentions. Requests for unannounced Mass intentions, those offered on an unspecified day and/or location, are also being accepted. It is preferred that all requests for Mass intentions, both announced and unannounced, be made in person at the parish office during regular business hours. A donation of \$10 per Mass is requested.

The bishop of the Diocese of Portland (Maine) has declared that distributing the Precious Blood during all Masses within that diocese is suspended until the flu epidemic passes. There are no restrictions for us here in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia; however, the action of the Bishop of Portland indicates how serious the situation is. Everyone is encouraged to do his/her part in helping to minimize the potential spread of the flu virus. For the exchange of the Sign of Peace, a simple nod of the head to the people around you would suffice. Also, it is strongly suggested that those not feeling well to please refrain from receiving the Precious Blood.

In addition to the ongoing project of having the stained glass windows in the church refurbished, the sacristy will begin to undergo a makeover in the very near future. When completed, the sacristy will be equipped with a bathroom.

By way of reminder, In the event inclement weather causes Upper Merion Area School District to either delay the start of the school day or close the schools, morning Masses will be cancelled and the intentions for those Masses will be transferred to the next available day. The safety of everyone, particularly our seniors who attend Mass regularly on weekdays, is paramount.

Registered parishioners of Sacred Heart parish are eligible to receive a 20% discount on any new pre-purchase of a grave, crypt, or niche in Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery. Interest-free financing is available. Please call the cemetery office (610-272-4088) during regular business hours for more information. This offer is good for the entire year.
