Dear Friends,

In addition to today being the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, it is also the World Day for Consecrated Life. Today we honor, give thanks, and pray for men and women who have taken the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience for the sake of Christ and his church. A brief description of the different forms of consecrated life can be found in the Faith Formation section of today's bulletin.

The 2020 Catholic Charities Appeal has begun; its theme is GIVING HOPE TO ALL. Money raised provides funding for Catholic Social Services (including Nutritional Development Services), Catholic Special Education, Skilled Care for Retired and Sick Priests, Mission Parishes, the Office for Life and Family, Cultural Ministries, and Foundation Activities. Sacred Heart parishioners gave \$15,669 from 171 donors to the 2019 Appeal. We reached 92% of our \$17,000 goal; the goal for 2020 is unchanged. Thank you for your generosity.

All funds donated to the 2020 Catholic Charities Appeal remain separate and distinct from Archdiocesan funds. Catholic Charities Appeal funds are deposited into an account maintained and governed by a **separate 501 (c) (3) account**. Funds given to the Catholic Charities Appeal are used exclusively for the purposes outlined in the case for support. Thank you for your donations amounting to \$1,211 in the recent second collection for Catholic Relief Services.

The archdiocese is asking parishes to hold a second collection to assist the people of Puerto Rico with relief efforts following a series of severe earthquakes and aftershocks that has severely damaged or destroyed many homes and much of the infrastructure. This collection will take place in Sacred Heart next weekend.

The next parish Holy Hour will begin at 7 PM on Monday, February 10, the Memorial of Saint Scholastica. All are invited to join our parish's Holy Name Society and Rosary Society in offering the Rosary and Evening Prayer.

By way of reminder, In the event inclement weather causes Upper Merion Area School District to either delay the start of the school day or close the schools, morning Masses will be cancelled and the intentions for those Masses will be transferred to the next available day. The safety of everyone, particularly our seniors who attend Mass regularly on weekdays, is paramount.

Registered parishioners of Sacred Heart parish are eligible to receive a 20% discount on any new pre-purchase of a grave, crypt, or niche in Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery. Interest-free financing is available. Please call the cemetery office (610-272-4088) during regular business hours for more information. This offer is good until the end of the year.

A very limited number of Sunday Masses between now and the end of June remain available for a specific intention. Also, weekday Masses at 8 AM and especially at 6:30 AM between now and the end of June remain available for specific intentions. Requests for unannounced Mass intentions, those offered on an unspecified day and/or location, are also being accepted. It is preferred that all requests for Mass intentions, both announced and unannounced, be made in person at the parish office during regular business hours. A donation of \$10 per Mass is requested.

In order to help minimize the potential spread of the flu virus, you can give a simple nod of the head to the people around you at the Sign of Peace rather than a handshake. Those not feeling well are strongly urged to refrain from receiving the Precious Blood.

## MEMORIAL OF SAINT SCHOLASTICA

*Virgin and Religious Founder, native of Nursia, first Benedictine nun, who lived between 480 and 543. She used to say, "Either speak of God or keep silence, for, what in this world is so worthy of speech?" Of God, Scholastica loved to speak above all with her twin brother, Saint Benedict, whom she would meet once a year.*

## *Faith Formation*

Today is the World Day of Consecrated Life. Here is a summary of the different forms of consecrated life in the church as found in The Catechism of the Catholic Church.

**Eremitic Life**--Without always professing the three evangelical counsels publicly, hermits "devote their life to the praise of God and salvation of the world through a stricter separation from the world, the silence of solitude and assiduous prayer and penance."

**Consecrated Virgins**--From apostolic times Christian virgins, called by the Lord to cling only to him with greater freedom of heart, body, and spirit, have decided with the Church's approval to live in the respective states of virginity "for the sake of the Kingdom of heaven."

**Religious Life**--Religious life was born in the East during the first centuries of Christianity. Lived within institutes canonically erected by the Church, it is distinguished from other forms of consecrated life by its liturgical character, public profession of the evangelical counsels, fraternal life led in common, and witness given to the union of Christ with the Church.

**Secular Institutes**--"A secular institute is an institute of consecrated life in which the Christian faithful living in the world strive for the perfection of charity and work for the sanctification of the world especially from within."

**Societies of Apostolic Life**--Alongside the different forms of consecrated life are "societies of apostolic life" whose members without religious vows pursue the particular apostolic purpose of their society, and lead a life as brothers or sisters in common according to a particular manner of life.
