Dear Friends,

Wednesday, February 26, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the season of Lent. Ashes will be distributed during the 6:30 AM and 8:00 AM Masses as well as during Liturgical services at 12:15 PM and 7:00 PM. No one is under any obligation to receive ashes; however, we are obliged on Ash Wednesday and all the days of Lent to heed the call of the Gospel to reform our lives by carrying out the traditional works of penance - prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The schedule of Devotions and Faith Formation events during Lent appears elsewhere in the parish bulletin.

All persons 14 years of age and older are seriously bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Further, all persons from the ages of 18 through 59 are seriously bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by limiting themselves to a single full meal and two light meals. Both church laws on fast and abstinence give us the very minimum acts of penance we are to perform during Lent. Of course, one can do more than the minimum, for example, abstain from meat an additional day of the week, or make every Friday during Lent a day of fast and abstinence.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed this Friday evening at 7 PM.

Fewer than 30 tickets remain for the parish trip to the Sight and Sound Theatre to see “Queen Esther” on Thursday, April 30. All interested in attending are highly encouraged to make their reservations as soon as possible. Cost of the trip is \$110 per person and include ticket to the show, meal following the show, round trip bus transportation and gratuity. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Everyone is aware of the seriousness of the coronavirus. To help minimize its potential spread, please consider giving another form of greeting other than a handshake to those around you during the Sign of Peace. Also, it is strongly suggested that those not feeling well to please refrain from receiving the Precious Blood.

Archbishop Nelson Pérez will be the principal celebrant and homilist at the annual Archdiocesan Mass Honoring the Gifts of Persons with Disabilities, the Deaf Community, Family, Friends and Caregivers on Saturday, March 21, 2020 at 10:30 AM at the Cathedral Basilica of SS. Peter and Paul at 18th and Benjamin Franklin Parkway, Philadelphia. A reception follows the Mass. All are welcome.

The Saint John Neumann Chapter of Catholics United for the Faith is hosting a Day of Recollection and Conference on “You are Called to Holiness” on Saturday, April 4, 2020, at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia. Featured speaker is Cardinal Raymond Burke, Member and Prefect Emeritus, Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura in Rome. The day includes Eucharistic Adoration, recitation of the Rosary and the presence of the National Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. Cardinal Burke will be the main celebrant of the Cathedral’s 5:15 PM Palm Sunday Vigil Mass. Reservations are required to attend. Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Archdiocese for the Military Services was established by Saint John Paul II in 1985 to provide a full range of Catholic pastoral ministries to those in the United States Armed Forces.

The mission of the Archdiocese is to "serve those who serve" by offering pastoral care to Catholics serving in the U.S. Military, enrolled in the nation's service academics, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs' Medical Centers in the United States, Puerto Rico and Guam, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders, and the families of these populations. The Archdiocese and its priests and deacons are responsible for pastoral service to approximately 1.8 million Catholics. However, unlike a conventional diocese, the Archdiocese has no parishes or parish registries and no weekly collections. It relies solely on the generosity of private donations to support its programs and services.

Last year, Pope Francis told military ordinaries from around the world that "The role of military chaplains is to accompany and support {those in need} on the journey, to be a comforting and brotherly presence for them all." Your support of the Archdiocese for the Military Services will bring the Gospel, the sacraments and other forms of spiritual support to men and women who serve our country and defend our freedoms, including many individuals and families who hail from our own Greater Philadelphia region.

The collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services will be conducted in your parish on the weekend of February 29 - March 1. I ask your continued prayers and generous financial support for this important collection.

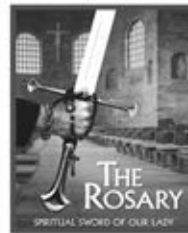
